Each year we offer an array of opportunities to School of Music students. These include:

- the Friends Student Grants assist students with their music education.
- the **Performance Travel Grant** supports travel costs for performance students to attend their instrumental lessons if a suitable teacher is not available in Canberra.
- the Fankhauser Travelling Fellowship supports students to attend or compete in national or international performance competitions, perform in festivals, undertake high-level performance training or perform in orchestras, ensembles or other music groups where selection is competitive.
- the Christel Larko Music Award supports students undertaking a program of study specialising in keyboard or voice and who demonstrate an outstanding level of musical ability and accomplishment.
- the Music Enterprise Award assists graduates and graduating students as young entrepreneurs to establish successful, sustainable businesses.
- the **Transition Award** assists students with the transition between formal study and a professional career in music.
